

Trinity Episcopal Church-on-the-Green Columbarium Memorial Gift Information

There are numerous ways to commemorate your family or loved ones at Trinity Church-on-the-Green, whether or not you are purchasing a space in the Columbarium, through the purchase of one or more of the following items. An inscription will be placed on or near the item to commemorate the name of the loved one.

Memorial chapel altar	<i>*given by Judith Long 2009</i>
Wood and gilt cross	<i>*given by Judith Long 2009</i>
Two meditation benches	<i>*given by Len and Michele Schiraldi 2009</i>

- Decorative grille “fencing” for \$20,000 (or \$10,000 each side)
- Decorative grille gates (*as a component of metalwork*) for \$7,500
- Terrazzo floor with Alpha-Omega medallion for \$4,000
- Two bronze candlesticks for Columbarium altar for \$1,600 (the pair)
- Thirty bronze vases w/copper inserts for \$800 each
- Commemoration on the Memorial Plaque for \$1000.00

All memorial gifts are tax deductible. (*Other than intangible religious benefits, no goods or services have been received by donor.*)
