

Family Faith Activity for March: A Litany of Thanks

On the first Sunday of Lent, it is tradition at Trinity Church to sing "The Great Litany" at the beginning of the Service. A litany is a listing of prayer requests which are presented in two parts: the first part is sung by the presider of the Service and the second part is sung by everyone else.

Here, you get to write your own Litany of Thanks. Think of things for which are thankful — maybe a family member, friend, special ability, something on Earth, etc. Write it in the blank space.
